TEE Overview

The Trusted Eagle Eye (TEE) is a public-private partnership program that was formed to encompass public agencies from the emergency response sector and government and private entities including businesses and community groups. The program was conceptualized in an effort to minimize crimes and their effect on the business community and its patrons as well as the general public.

TEE Benefits

The benefits of the TEE program to its members are numerous; among them:

Improved and Expedited Response for a Trusted Security

- Continuous monitoring for criminal activities of common areas including roads and parking lots;
- Documentation of evidentiary recordings, if and when available, for legal and insurance purposes;
- Coordination between Ops Center staff, on-scene first responders, and agency executives with audio and video capabilities;
- Dissemination of mass and customized alerts to business managers/owners and residents should the need arise;
- Significant money savings in manpower and resources for businesses to achieve similar, yet more beneficial, goals on their own;
- Maintaining a safe community for customers, employees, residents, and tourists.



Events and Abnormal Conditions Live Updates

- Traffic Management during Major Events;
- Email broadcasting of road conditions during abnormal circumstance such as sever weather conditions;
- Calendar of major events in the community to help businesses capitalize on increase traffic.



Risk Mitigation for an Improved Emergency Preparedness

- Quarterly meetings with elected officials and chiefs for an idea-exchange and to improve coordinated efforts;
- Quarterly meetings under the series, "Hear from the Experts," on issues that matter to the Community. These meetings host recognized Subject-Matter Experts (SMEs) and Lawmakers;
- Bi-annual Table Top Exercise for Emergency Preparedness;
- Dedicated team to direct Emergency Management Activities;
- Coordinate donation requests during emergencies saving time and money.
